

Multidimensional Use of Effective Microorganisms - Case Studies from Holland

Abstract : *The maintenance or possibly increasing productivity through low levels of inputs was considered non-feasible for a long period of time. However sustainable agriculture through nature forming strives to achieve that with many instances in Holland and adopted by agriculturists. An active research project was carried out at Wageningen, which showed positive effects of EM on soils and pastures. Projects are underway to treat water with EM based products, while wastes from breweries are made into compost or organic fertilizers. Silage is made with EM and fed to livestock and growth monitored. The most recent projects undertaken by Agriton and research institutions in Holland will be highlighted.*
